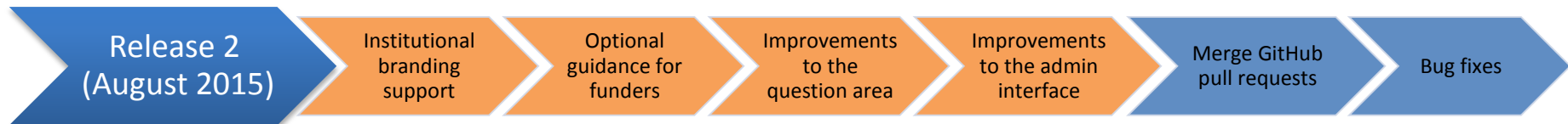


DMPonline Release Note

Description	Incremental release of DMPonline version 4 corresponding to roadmap release for August 2015.

New Features

The new features included in this release of DMPonline are listed in the table below:

Feature	Theme	Description
Institutional branding	Usability improvements	Feature that allows organisations to customise the top banner on DMPonline tool. Administrators will be able to enter a paragraph and, when a logo is provided, it will be displayed to all users who belong to that organisation.
Optional guidance for funders	Usability improvements	Feature to support optional guidance to funders' templates. Gives the user the ability to select additional guidance from the funder.
Improvements to the question area	Usability improvements	Improvements to presentation in the question area. The use of a scroll bar when 'Suggested answers' are too long, as well as the 'Comments' label was changed to 'Notes'.
Improvements to the admin interface	Usability improvements	Feature to enable the display of the 'comment' field under multiple choice questions. This feature will be maintained when a plan is being exported.
GitHub pull requests	Active Maintenance	Because DMPonline code is licensed under GNU License and is available in GitHub, it has a number of collaborators who download and install their own instance of DMPonline. These collaborators help make improvements to the code and create pull requests, some of which have now been merged with DMPonline code.

Unfortunately, not all features planned for this release have been included in the delivery. The improved layout, presenting complex guidance and DMP statistics dashboard was not implemented, due to staff shortages in the DCC developer team.

The various releases present in the DMPonline roadmap will still take place, but to a revised timescale.

Bugfix/invalid edit plan section response	Active Maintenance	<p>When user opens the section of the plan, it periodically checks the locks for every 50 seconds. In <i>plans.js</i>, <i>check_section_lock()</i> function sends a post request to <code>\$.post('lock_section', {section_id: section_id});</code> and it returns a huge html content, which takes around 3 seconds to process. This lowers the server performance when a high number of users are using the tool at the same time. This pull request changes the post request to <i>lock_section.json</i>. Add GNU Affero Licence	Active Maintenance	<p>GNU Affero Licence was added to GitHub.</p> <p>Thank you to Michael Jackson https://github.com/DigitalCurationCentre/DMPonline_v4/pull/160</p>
Flash not displaying for reCAPTCHA failures	Active Maintenance	<p>If the user does not enter a valid reCAPTCHA, then no error message is displayed. The problem seemed to be with <i>app/controllers/contacts_controller.rb</i> which sets flash values with the key <code>:error</code>. According to the Rails documentation on the flash, only <code>:notice</code> and <code>:alert</code> are supported. Replaced <i>flash[:error]</i> with <i>flash[:alert]</i> so the flashes appear on the title screen.</p> <p>Thank you to Michael Jackson https://github.com/DigitalCurationCentre/DMPonline_v4/pull/161</p>

Present Shibboleth-specific content only if <code>config.shibboleth_enabled</code>	Active Maintenance	<p>Present Shibboleth-specific content only if <i>config.shibboleth_enabled</i> is true. <i>config/application.rb</i> defines a <i>config.shibboleth_enabled</i> flag. <i>_login_form.html.erb</i> and <i>edit.html.erb</i> updated to access the value of this flag, via the reference <i>Rails.application.config.shibboleth_enabled</i>.</p> <p>Thank you to Michael Jackson https://github.com/DigitalCurationCentre/DMPonline_v4/pull/165</p>

Bug Fixes

The bug fixes included in this release of DMPonline are listed in the table below:

Issue	Theme	Description
Version control of a template	Active Maintenance	When a version of a phase is saved as 'published', previous versions will be set to 'unpublished' automatically. This had to be done manually in the past.
Comment field missing from exporting	Active Maintenance	'Comment' field under multiple choice questions was not being displayed when a plan was being exported in pdf format. This has now been fixed.
Comment field for multiple-choice questions	Active Maintenance	The 'Comment' field was not being displayed under questions that required multiple-choice answers – this has now been fixed.
